

PRIVACY POLICY OF THE WEBSITE

Data controller

Ekoenergetyka Sales Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Łódź (90-063) at ul. Piotrkowska 148/150.

Personal data

1. Personal data collected by the Data controller via the website is processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection), hereinafter referred to as the GDPR and the Act on the protection of personal data of 10 May 2018.

2. The Data controller processes personal data (name and email address) via the website www.chargeyourworld.com when the user uses the contact form, on the basis of the user's consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR) and for purposes arising from legitimate interests (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR).

3. The data shall be processed for a time period of minimum 2 years in order to fulfill the obligations arising from the requirements of the inquiry or until the user withdraws his or her consent.

4. When using the website, the following data will also be collected: the visitor's IP address and the IP address from which the message was sent, geographical location, version and type of the internet browser, as well as information about the time and method of browsing the website.

5. Providing data is voluntary. The Data controller shall exercise due diligence to protect the interests of the data subjects, and, in particular, to ensure that the data collected is: processed in accordance with the law, collected for specified, lawful purposes and not subject to further processing inconsistent with these purposes, correct in terms of content and adequate in relation to the purposes for which it is processed and stored in a form that allows identification of the data subject, no longer than necessary to achieve the purpose of the processing.

Sharing personal data

1. Personal data is transferred to service providers used by the Data controller for operating the website, including in particular hosting providers and entities providing tools for analysing the internet traffic - Google Analytics.

2. The data subject has the right to access his or her personal data, modify, delete it, limit its processing, transfer it, object to or withdraw his or her consent to its processing at any time

without affecting the lawfulness of processing executed on the basis of the data subject's consent before its withdrawal.

3. In order to exercise the rights referred to in point 2, an appropriate message should be sent to: ee.sales@ekoenergetyka.com.pl .

4. If a user requests to exercise any of his or her rights mentioned above, the Data controller may comply with or refuse the request immediately, but no later than within one month after receiving the request. However, if - due to the complex nature of the request or the number of requests - the Data controller will not be able to comply with the request within a period of one month, he shall do so within the next two months, informing the user in advance within one month of receiving the request about the intended extension of that period and its reason.

5. If of personal data is found to violate the provisions of the GDPR, the data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

Cookie files

1. Cookie files are IT data, in particular text files, which are downloaded and stored on the end device of the website user for the time specified in the file parameters or until they are deleted by the user. Cookie files store information that is often necessary for the website to function properly, and includes, in particular, the name of the website which they originate from, their storage time on the end device, and a unique number.

2. In order to analyse user traffic on the website, we use Google Analytics tool, which uses cookies to recognize the user's computer every time he or she is visiting the website. These files are used to analyse how the website is used in order to compile general statistics on website visits. 3. Cookie files are required for the proper provision of services on the website and for better understanding of the user's interactions with the contents of the website.

4. The user has the right to decide on the cookie settings for a particular end device by selecting them in the browser window. Detailed information about the use of cookies is available in the web browser settings.

Final provisions

1. The Data controller shall use technical and organizational means in order to ensure protection of the personal data processed, and, in particular, to protect it against disclosure to unauthorized persons, its processing in violation of applicable laws, as well as against loss, damage or destruction.

2. The Data controller shall provide appropriate technical means preventing acquisition and modification of personal data by unauthorized persons.

3. For matters not regulated by this Privacy Policy, the provisions of the GDPR and other relevant provisions of Polish law shall apply.
